

Length of Registration Periods

Whilst all Registration Standards are required to be met, the Registration Board has determined that where Registration Standards are not met and conditions of registration are to be issued, then the length of registration period will also be considered by the Board.

The Board has determined that where Registration Standards 3 Curriculum, 5 Student Welfare, 6 Financial Resources and 7 Staff are not met, it considers that there is a significant risk in allowing too much time for a school to continue to operate without a full re-registration process being again undertaken. As such the Board has determined that it will take the following into consideration when determining the period of registration when re-registering a school.

**An Inspection does not usually require documentation to be provided, however the Registrar will advise should any documentation be required. From 2022, Inspections will also have a focus on the implementation of the Board Guidelines V3.0 approved by the Minister for Education on 7 July 2021. These Guidelines contain amendments relating to the implementation of the recommendations from the Royal Commission into Institutional Responses to Child Sexual Abuse.*
